UQRCS Toowoomba delivers Phase II of the MD Program. Third and fourth year students are placed in both the public and private sectors. Our regional community is particularly fortunate to have a broad range of specialist practices which enhances learning opportunities for our students. Students undertaking clinical placements benefit from a very high preceptor to student ratio.

Our First Year Observership Program has been tailored to provide students with the opportunity to experience the many advantages that rural practice and community offers. A comprehensive Orientation Program conducted on day one will include clinical orientation activities. Clinical Skills simulation opportunities will be available during the course of the Program.

Students who successfully place to the Observership Program will need to demonstrate their interest in rural and regional medicine. A competitive selection process will be undertaken. When applying for consideration please provide a half page (250 word maximum) "Expression of Interest" detailing the reasons for your interest in a placement at UQRCS Toowoomba.

In 2017 we are offering six placements over the period 20 November to 15 December.

During the Observership students will be involved in the day to day activities related to ward and clinic work. As well, there will be opportunities to observe in other hospital departments. Some facilities that are not on the Toowoomba Hospital campus but which are located in private hospitals (such as Cardiac Catheter Laboratory or Radiation Oncology) can be included in the Observership Program depending on demand.
