## Tips

- Preference the **rotation order** you want for 2018. Keep in mind *when* you want to go back to Australia and for *which course/discipline*. You will preference the **course/discipline** for your Australia rotation on June 7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup>.
- If there is a certain **course** you want to do in AUS and during a particular rotation, then you should preference your rotation order accordingly. For example:
  - You want to do Medical Specialties in Rotation 3 in AUS. Preference your rotation order with Medical Specialties as Rotation 3. When rotation orders are confirmed on May 30<sup>th</sup>, if you get Medical Specialties in Rotation 3 then you will rank Medical Specialties as 1<sup>st</sup> when you preference for the AUS rotation.
  - If you get Medical Specialties in Rotation 1, but you know you prefer to do Medical Specialties in AUS in Rotation 3, then you will need to arrange a *self-swap* of rotations during the Swap Request period from May 31<sup>st</sup> – June 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - Keep in mind that you may not get your 1<sup>st</sup> preference for Australia and need to plan on that when planning your rotation order.
- **Note** – On June 7<sup>th</sup> when you preference for your AUS rotation, the system will only allow you to rank the courses you prefer to do for the required AUS rotation, not the rotation number. Therefore, you will need to know your rotation **order** before preferencing the **course** for AUS.
- **Additional AUS Rotations:** If you want to do more than one rotation in AUS, the system will only allow you to select one, to fulfill your requirement. You may be able to request additional AUS rotations at the end of Rotation 5, after all grades have been finalized. Please contact Ochsner Student Affairs after this time to notify us of your interest. Nothing can be done prior to the finalization of grades at the end of the year.
